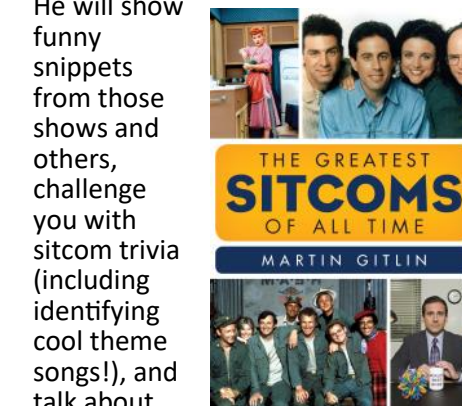
### A Funny Program About Funny Programs: The Greatest Sitcoms of All Time
